PROGRAMME OUTCOMES

The B.A. program in the college is recognized by Sambalpur University and follows the CBCS (CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM) syllabus by the university. Our students are allowed to choose from any of the five Subjects as Honors from the cluster of EDUCATION, ECONOMICS, POLITICAL SCIENCE, HISTORY and ODIA. Beside the above subjects AECC (ABILITY ENHANCEMENT COMPULSORY COURSE), SECC(SKILL ENHANCEMENT COMPULSORY COURSE), and GE(GENERIC ELECTIVE) are also prescribed in the program by the university. B.A program in our institution meets the standard prescribed by general humanities education.

Some of the program outcomes are follows

- 1. On graduating the students will be eligible for employment in school and college. Students also become employable in governmental and non-governmental organizations.
- 2. They will also be able to appear for competitive examinations conducted for public sector jobs. The general humanities education furnishes them to clear competitive exams.
- Humanities education is designed in such a way that it lays particular emphasis on human values. Students on completion on the under graduate degree will be better able to appreciate the literary and cultural diversity.

COURSE OUTCOMES

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION-

- 1. Students have an ability of understanding the human psychology, from childhood to adulthood.
